

HCCAC to receive Follies 2017 funds

Greenville Follies has named Hunt County Children's Advocacy Center as the recipient for the 2017 Follies production. The April 28 & 29, 2017 performances will benefit the HCCAC's second floor renovation project.

Hunt County Children's Advocacy Center provides comprehensive services to victims of child abuse and sexual assault in Hunt County. Services include on-site sexual assault medical services and professional counseling.

Renovation of the second floor of the HCCAC building at 2604 Lee Street will provide spaces for Art Therapy, Music Therapy, Pet Therapy and Play Therapy to enhance therapeutic services and aid in healing for children who have been victims of abuse. The two floors will be connected by a locomotive-themed elevator dubbed "The Follies Express" as well as a spiral staircase and sliding pole. The Center anticipates working with local businesses and artists to create this unique space.

Please note: HCCAC and CASA are not the same organization! CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocates) volunteers advocate for a child's best interests in the foster care/child protection system. HCCAC staff and volunteers provide support for the abused child's physical and mental health to help children overcome the trauma of abuse.
